With this in mind, Prairie Piecemakers has chosen our show theme, Quilts Unlimited. Our logo, a collection of arrows, symbolizes quilting going in every imaginable direction!

We invite all quilters to help us showcase the art of quilting in its many forms.

Show Categories

Judged Categories

1. Small Quilts - Hand or machine quilted: maximum 160 inch perimeter
2. Medium Quilts - Hand quilted or hand appliqued: maximum perimeter of 240 inches
3. Medium Quilts - Self Machine Quilted: maximum perimeter of 240 inches
4. Medium Quilts - Professionally Machine Quilted: maximum perimeter of 240 inches
5. Large Quilts - Hand quilted or hand appliqued: greater than 240 inch perimeter
6. Large Quilts - Self Machine Quilted: greater than 240 inch perimeter
7. Large Quilts - Professionally Machine Quilted: greater than 240 inch perimeter
8. Innovative Quilts - Mixed Media: maximum perimeter of 240 inches
9. Innovative Quilts - Fabric based: maximum perimeter of 240 inches
10. Innovative Quilts - 3-Dimensional object with a quilted element.
11. Group Quilts - Completed by 2 or more people: any size
12. Wearables - Clothing with a quilted element
13. Recycled - Made from recycled fabrics or materials: any size
14. Traditional Meets Innovative - A quilt that incorporates both traditional quilting techniques and innovative fabrics, designs or embellishments: any size
15. Art Inspirations - A quilt that interprets a work of art: any size. Attach photo of art piece you are interpreting.

Non-judged Category

16. Display only - A limited number of display only quilts will be accepted as space permits.

How to Enter

One - Send your entry form

Please send your entry form, along with disclaimer of responsibility and entry fee (if applicable) **no later than August 20, 2010** to Sharon Fraser, by mail to Unit #20, 4901 Child Ave, Regina, SK, S4X 4T7; or by email to appliquequeen@accesscomm.ca. When we receive your entry form, we'll send you a Quilt ID Tag and a Claim Tag,

Quilters who are not members of our guild need to enclose an entry fee of \$10 to cover all of their entries. There is no limit to the number of entries per person. Please choose your category carefully to ensure that quilts are judged and displayed in the most appropriate category.

Two - Create your quilt and package it

Complete your quilt, and package it in a fabric bag. Label the back of the quilt and the bag clearly with your name, address and phone number. Include the Quilt ID Tag.

Three - Drop off or send your quilt

Please deliver your quilt between 7 p.m. and 9 p.m. Tuesday, September 21.

If you live outside Regina you may mail or courier your quilts to Sharon Fraser by September 21st. Regina quilters, if you are unable to deliver your pieces during the specified time, please make alternate arrangements with Sharon or one of the members listed above.

Four - Claim your quilt

Quilts must be picked up at Conexus Arts Centre on Sunday, September 26 between 6:00 pm and 6:30 pm unless alternate arrangements have been made.

Prizes

For each of the judged categories a First prize of \$75; Second prize of \$50 and Third prize of \$25 may be awarded by our judges.

Other prizes: Judges' overall choice - \$150; Viewers choice - \$150; Best of theme - \$50; Best use of colour - \$50 and Best Vendor's Booth - \$50.
