

Quilt Show Rules

1. Any entry must have been completed within the last two years with the exception of Category 17, which must have been completed within the past five years and Category 18, which must have been completed within the past three years. All entries must not have been previously shown in any Moose Jaw 'Prairie Hearts' Quilt Show.
2. Quilted items must have at least 3 distinct layers and must have some quilting visible on each side with the exception of Category 23 and 24 which must have quilting visible on at least one side. Framed entries will not be accepted into the show.
3. **All work must be your own** in all categories with the exception of Categories 11, 12, 13, 19 and 20. Mid/Long arm quilted items **MUST** be entered in Categories 11, 12, 13 and 29 only.
4. In all categories you must state who it is pieced by, quilted by, and the origin of the pattern if known. (Eg: The name of the book and author, or magazine name, and issue it came from.)
5. Only one entry per category is allowed. Entrants may enter up to 6 categories from 1 to 28. Special Awards Quilt (SAQ) and Guild Challenge (GC) are limited to one entry per person. Items not entered in the appropriate category will be placed in Category 29 – Display Only.
6. Entries in Category 29 may be limited due to space. Priority will be given to those entrants who do not have any other entries in the show. You will be informed between the entry due date and quilt drop off date if we do not have space for your entry.
7. There is a \$10.00 entry fee for non-guild members. This fee covers all of your entries whether you do one entry or the maximum of seven entries (six category entries plus Special Award Quilt entry). Please make cheques payable to: Moose Jaw Prairie Hearts Quilters' Guild.
8. Hanging sleeves are preferred on all quilts that are less than 36 inches in height. For any quilts that are longer than 36 inches in width and less than 36 inches in height, we ask that you put a split sleeve on the quilt, rather than one continuous sleeve. Hanging sleeves must be at least 2 inches wide.

Quilt Show Categories

Hand Quilted – Quilt top and quilting must be completed by the same person.

1. Hand Quilted – Quilt greater than 300” in perimeter
2. Hand Quilted – Quilt less than 299” in perimeter
3. Hand Quilted – Wall Hanging – any size

Machine Quilted – Quilt top and quilting must be completed by the same person.

4. Machine Quilted – Quilt greater than 300” in perimeter
5. Machine Quilted – Quilt less than 299” in perimeter
6. Machine Quilted – Wall Hanging – any size

Hand Appliqué

7. Hand Appliqué – Quilt – greater than 200” in perimeter
8. Hand Appliqué – Wall Hanging – any size

Machine Appliqué

9. Machine Appliqué – Quilt – greater than 200” in perimeter
10. Machine Appliqué – Wall hanging – any size

Mid/Long Arm Quilted – Quilt was quilted on a Mid/Long arm machine

11. Mid/Long Arm Quilted – Quilt greater than 300” in perimeter; this may be professionally quilted.
12. Mid/Long Arm Quilted – Quilt less than 299” in perimeter; this may be professionally quilted.
13. Mid/Long Arm Quilted – Wall hanging – any size; this may be professionally quilted.
14. **Art Quilt** – any size, must be an original design; must include two or more dominant techniques including but not limited to appliqué, piecing, embroidery, dyeing, embellishment, painting, machine quilting and hand quilting. Must not be the finished project of a workshop or class.
15. **Youth Quilt** – High School Student only with minimal adult help – any size, any technique. Any adult help must be stated: who helped and what did the adult do? This will be a judged category with first, second and honourable participant awarded.
16. **Youth Quilt** – Elementary School Student only with minimal adult help – any size, any technique. Any adult help must be stated: who helped and what did the adult do? This will be a judged category with first, second and honourable participant awarded.
17. **Beginner Quilt** – any size, any technique, may be part of a beginner or a learn-to-quilt workshop or class. Must have started quilting within the last 5 years.
18. **Senior Quilt** – any size, any technique; must be made by a quilter 80 years or older; must have been made within the past three years and not been shown in any Moose Jaw Prairie Hearts Quilt Show.

19. **Friendship / Group Quilt –Hand Quilted** - any size; work on this quilt that of more than one person (i.e. Block exchange, round robin, group exchange, etc); names of all who contributed to the quilt should be on the label.
20. **Friendship / Group Quilt – Machine Quilted** NOT Mid/Long Arm Quilted – any size; work on this quilt is that of more than one person (i.e. Block exchange, round robin, group exchange, etc.); names of all who contributed to the quilt should be on the label.
21. **Varied Techniques (Basic)** – any size; includes but not limited to machine embroidery, photo transfer, rag quilts, tied quilts.
22. **Varied Techniques (Advanced)** – any size; includes but not limited to hand piecing, English paper piecing, crazy quilts, hand embroidery, Battenburg lace, thread painting.
23. **Quilted Garments** – must be wearable, pieced and/or appliquéd. Quilting must be visible. May use recycled material as some or part of your fabric choices.
24. **Quilted Bags** – must have visible quilting on at least 50% of the bag.
25. **Recycled Quilt** – any size; no garments; 50% of the fabrics must come from a recycle source (old bedspreads, ties, coats, draperies, etc.); please indicate the recycled materials.
26. **Miniature Quilt** – less than 72” perimeter – based on a traditional design – may be pieced or appliquéd.
27. **Paper Pieced Quilt** – any size; the majority of the quilt must have used paper piecing technique.
28. **Table Runners or Placemats or Tree Skirts only**
29. **Display only** – not to be judged, may be Mid/Long Arm Quilted by student or professional.

Special Award Quilt (SAQ) – Prairie Colours

Start with an original photo of a prairie scene. Select three or more colours from your photo and create a quilt of any size and any style. This does not have to be a reproduction of your photo but it **MUST** contain three or more colours from your photo. Other colours may be added. Your photo must be submitted with your entry. Clearly indicate which three colours you have selected and where they appear in the photo and where they appear in your quilt.

Guild Challenge (GC) – A Prairie Fabric Challenge

Heather’s Quilting Pallet, Quilters Haven and The Quilt Patch have each selected one prairie fabric. You must use at least four square inches of each fabric and add at least one other fabric to create a quilt of any size and any style. The three selected fabrics and at least one of your choice must be clearly visible on the front of your quilt.
