

3D Poinsettia Presentation by Jacquie Berger¹

Pick your fabric

- print or focus fabric, you need 4-5 repeats of the same flower.
- backing fabric, color to match flower in focus fabric.
- fabric & batting for mini quilt & binding.
- prepare your mini quilt: layer quilt & bind. Be sure to have a hanging tube on the back.

Fusible web

- fuse to wrong side of focus fabric.
- fussy cut out one flower & fuse to your mini quilt.
- fuse backing fabric to the rest of the focus fabric & fussy cut out 3-4 more of the same flower.



Some assembly required:

- trim away a few of the petals of the flower starting with the bottom most petals. Do this to all 3-4 flowers, the last flower having the least amount of petals.
- stitch the veins and or leaves of these flower parts or thread paint these flower parts using a metallic or rayon thread. Be sure to use the right needle for the job. If you have a single hole needle plate for your machine this is an advantage as well.
- hand stitch a pleat in the center of each flower part, leave a long tail of thread attached.
- hand stitch each flower part to the fused flower on the mini quilt, starting with the largest. Off set the flower parts slightly.
- finish by stitching a button or seed beads to the center of the flower.
