

We're now a little more than a month away from our quilt show. Please, please, please register your quilts and bring us some items to create our penny parade baskets. Also, please sign up for a volunteer shift or two. It's an opportunity to showcase our work, our guild, and support the art of quilting. By the time you are reading this, there will be about 2 weeks to register your quilts, and about 5 weeks until the actual quilt show.

Work also continues on our efforts to have Connected Threads Network gain registered charity status. This process is slow, but we're working on it steadily to do all the requirements necessarily before we make our application to the Canadian Revenue Agency.

I still have a couple of quilts to finish, but I've already registered them as a push to ensure I'll get them done in time for the quilt show.

One last thing our April guest is going to give us advice to simple stretches or exercises to keep us nimble and pain free - especially for those who spend hours sitting at a sewing machine. She will be giving us a demonstration, but also asking us to participate in those exercises if you'd like to join in. So, this is not the meeting to wear your prettiest dress and high heels or your figure-hugging jeans and tall boots. Think yoga pants, or at least something that will allow you to move. Guild Challenge for 2023-24

Be Sustainable



The challenge this year is to repurpose fabric into something new. These fabrics can be used clothing, bedding, table linens, upholstery, etc. The quilted project must be made from at least 75% used materials with unused fabric scraps from your stash making up the remainder of the quilt. If you have to purchase any fabric for your project, it should come from a thrift shop, garage sale, etc.

The same rule will apply to the back of the quilt. Hint: bed sheets make great backing!

Your quilt or object must not be longer than 85 inches. It can be wearable, a quilted object, a bag, wall hanging, etc. Where ever your imagination takes you!

All projects will be shown at the May 7, 2024 meeting. Each person will be given a number and Guild members will vote for viewer choice. Be sure to pin the registration paperwork to the back of your piece. No names should be shown on the front

Guild challenge projects **must be registered** to be displayed at the May quilt show. Check the Quilt Show guidelines for details.

If you do not want to display your guild challenge project you do not need to register but please bring it to the May guild meeting for showing.



Big Book of Baby Quilts by Martingale Publishing (\$33) - this book contains 87 patterns by various designers. You can't help but pick out something special to make from this book.
